Green campus initiative to kick off in city colleges

About 70 employees from Ajuba, who will be trained by CPREEC in this initiative, will then implement their environmental audit, supervised by scientists from CPREEC, in city colleges. Based on the report from this audit, green initiatives will be recommended to the concerned college.
